Sugar Corporate 6.5.1 Release Notes

Overview

This page describes changes to existing features, fixed issues, supported platforms, and acknowledgments for Sugar 6.5.1.

Changes in 6.5.1

- Global Search enabled automatically if Full Text Search (FTS) is disabled â Disabling FTS in Sugar 6.5.0 resulted in disabling all search functionality; Global Search is available in Sugar 6.5.1 when the FTS is disabled

Fixed issues in Sugar 6.5.1

The following High/UrgentPriority issues have been fixed in this release:

- 39599 : Lead data with special characters submitted via Web-to-Lead forms is truncated
- 40573 : Day: Date Created in Summation Reports does not convert to user's time zone
- 45282 : Change Log displays incomplete list of updates
- 50126 : Unchecking Create Account or Select Account in the Lead Conversion page empties the (Account) Name field
- 50437 : Email disappears from the Compose Email pane (Emails module) after switching to the Inbox tab, moving the separation pane, and returning to the Compose tab
- 50549 : Selecting Is Not filter for multiselect value displays records that match the excluded condition
- 50843 : Editing a Call record and saving it removes the Contact record from the Call
- 51192 : Modified By User incorrect in workflow alert email if modification is via import
- 51298 : Reports omit data for January 2012
- 51346 : Adding a second Team displays a field populated with 1 instead of a radio button in the Teams section of a record when viewed in Internet Explorer 9
- 51427 : Setting Calculated values to Name fields removes the records from Global Search
- 51719 : Data not displayed in Summation with Details report when used with

- 52000 : Creating a custom one-to-many relationship between a module and itself and selecting multiple records in the subpanel adds the last selected record only
 - 52263 : Sending an email with Gmail as the InboundEmail client creates two
 - 52361 : Products records are not displayed in sub-panels
 - 52543 : Editing Calendar activities in modules removes the records from Calendar
 - 52783 : Navigating to more records in List View of Leads and Contacts displays a blank page
 - 52796 : Incorrect Opportunity amounts are displayed in Reports if the conversion factor for currencies is changed
 - 52939 : Price field displays incorrect currencies in Products sub-panels
 - 53412 : Values in custom drop-down lists in Users module cannot be selected and saved
 - 53662 : Text from one email draft is copied to the second email draft if multiple email drafts are open in the Emails module
 - 53707 : Email is sent to incorrect recipient and contains incorrect body text if multiple drafts are open in the Emails module
 - 53713 : Repair/build sprite code does not check the custom/ directory for new images
 - 53963 : Indexes and primary keys missing in *_audit (for example, accounts_audit, contacts_audit, etc.) tables for DB2, Oracle and SQL Server databases
